Keep the same withholding rates for Federal taxes that I had in 2018	No	No	You do not need to send a 2019 Form W-4 if your Federal withholding rate was not EXEMPT in 2018 and you want your rate to stay the same as it was in 2018.
Keep the same withholding rates for state taxes that I had in 2018	No	Maybe	You do not need to send a 2019 Form OR-W-4 if your State withholding rate was not EXEMPT in 2018 and you want your rate to stay the same as it was in 2018. However, if you send in a <b>2019</b> Form W-4 for Federal purposes, you must submit a <b>2019</b> Form OR-W-4 too.
Claim 'Exempt' withholding status for Federal taxes	Yes	No	If you claimed EXEMPT on your 2018 W-4 form, we will send you a 2019 W-4 to sign and return by the date stated in the letter that comes with the form.
Claim 'Exempt' withholding status for State taxes	No	Yes	If you claimed EXEMPT for Federal and wish to claim EXEMPT for State, you must submit an OR-W-4.
Change my Federal tax withholding rate for 2019	Yes	No	Fill out and send IRS Form W-4 (2019)
Change my State tax withholding rate for 2019	No	Yes	Fill out and send 2019 Form OR-W-4
I earn overtime or travel time pay and I want my Federal tax withholding to be something other than the 'Single-zero' rate	Yes	No	Go to our program web page to download and print the form called 'W-4 for Overtime and Travel Time Payments- Federal' Fill out the form and send it to us.
I earn overtime or travel time pay and I want my State tax withholding to be something other than the 'Single-zero' rate	No	Yes	Go to our program web page to download and print the form called 'W-4 for Overtime and Travel Time Payments- State' Fill out the form and send it to us.
